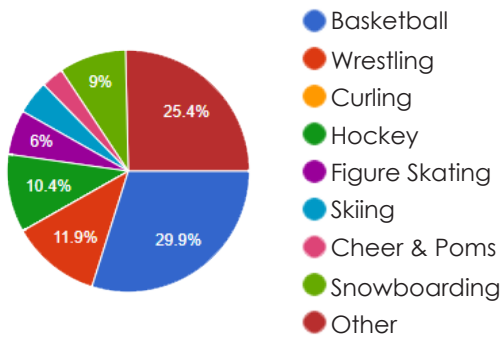

I eventually read the letter, and yearned to learn the author of it, so I could befriend and thank them.

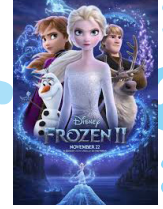

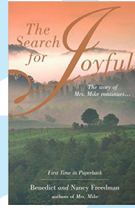

APPLE AND PUMPKIN FARM

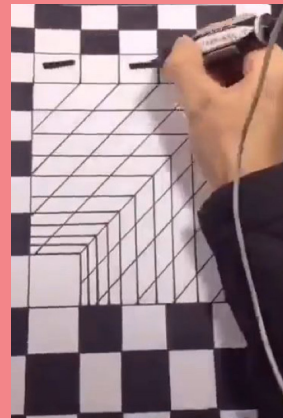

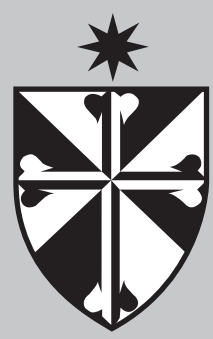

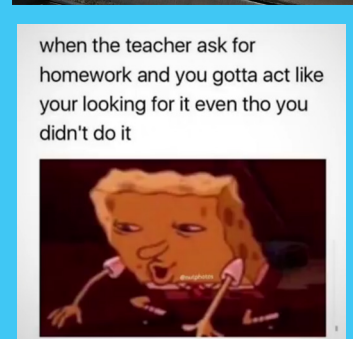

DIY Snowman Mason Jar

MATERIALS:

- Any type of fluffy material (preferably fluffy plastic snow)
- Mason jar
- Large red Pom Poms
- Red and white pipe cleaners
- Black buttons
- Orange air dry clay
- Glue gun
- Deco-page or mod-podge



DIRECTIONS:

1. Make a carrot nose out of the air dry clay.
2. With the hot glue gun, glue on the nose and 2 black buttons on mason jar, to make the face.
3. With the Deco-page or mod-podge, cover the mason jar with it. Cover it with plastic snow material (do this over something to create less of a mess) and left it dry.
4. Now to make the earmuffs cut one red and white pipe cleaner in half and twist them together. Mold them into a U shape.
5. Then grab the mason jar lid and glue 2 large red Pom poms to the side. Glue the twisted pipe cleaners on top.
6. Twist the lid back on and you're finished with your adorable snowman!

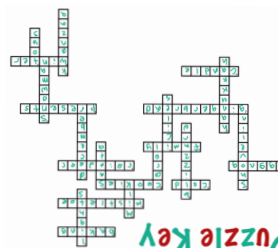

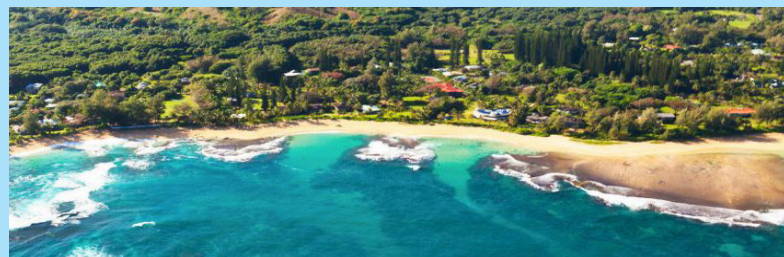
Aspen, Colorado
