Recently, I have found lots of projects from found objects or materials you can repurpose. I have a few ideas of gifts I want to make for my sister's house using rocks and reclaimed wood.



SEASHELL ART

We took a family vacation over a year ago to Florida, and we collected so many seashells that I still haven't used yet. I want to make a dragonfly or an eagle to hang in my house. I also want to try painting seashells using dot patterns.



ETCHING GLASS

We are in the process of making a light using bottles cut with a glass cutter. I want to try other glass bottle repurposing techniques, like etching glass. I need to purchasing Etching Cream and sticky stencils. I want to make some etched oil and vinegar bottles as well as glass soap dispensers for the kitchen and bath.

WATERCOLOR STAINED GLASS HEARTS

This project I tried with my kids, but they did more freestyle watercolor on their own while I tried to finish it myself. I think using sharpie for the black lines instead of black watercolor would have provided a cleaner look.



DIY SHIRT FOLDING BOARD

I made a folding board and tried it myself. It took me 11 seconds to fold a shirt with it, as opposed to 8 seconds the traditional way. It does make the shirt look less wrinkled though. My son tried and got faster each time. It was a little cumbersome for him to use on the floor, so I think the table would work best for adults and kids.



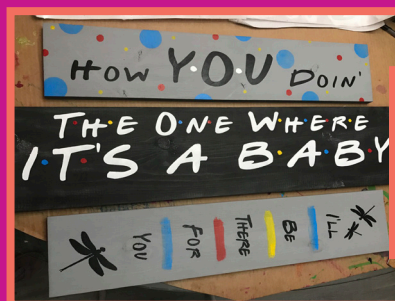
SINGLE-PANED WINDOW ACRYLIC PAINTING
