Many of the national, regional and local retailers want to help make private education more affordable, so these retailers offer to sacrifice a percentage of their profit to those who buy their gift cards. The money from these retailers goes right to sports fees or tuition payments. You get a share of this money buy purchasing gift cards through our school's SCRIP program. With each purchase, 70% of the money donated by the retailer goes right to the tuition account of the purchaser.
