- Non-alumnus employees or former employees of St. Catherine's shall be eligible for the St. Catherine's Alumni Hall of Fame if he or she: (1) has been employed by St. Catherine's for a minimum of four years, (2) has voluntarily left St. Catherine's employment after a minimum of five years.
- In rare and special circumstances, a non-alumnus volunteer for St. Catherine's shall be eligible for an Alumni Hall of Fame Certificate of Excellence if he or she has demonstrated outstanding service and dedication to the success of the school.
- Nominee must show excellence in his/her field of endeavor and live out the Dominican pillars of Community, Prayer, Service and Study.
