

Betty "Onnie" Lannoye '51 Scholarship

Betty "Onnie" Lannoye was a 1951 graduate of St. Catherine's who remained committed to her alma mater well beyond her graduation year – both financially and as an active member of the Class of '51 Reunion Committee. She was a dynamic member of St. Edward's parish as a member of the choir, the Women of St. Edward's, the Stewardship Committee, Parish Council and as a volunteer for festivals, rummage sales, dinners and the REST program for the homeless. Throughout her life, Onnie also enjoyed the arts and participated in a variety of related activities: singing, drama, painting, ceramics and photography.

This \$1,000 scholarship is for students who are both active in their parish and interested in pursuing some aspect of fine or performing arts. This scholarship may be awarded to a student in any grade; eligible winners may also reapply in subsequent years. Financial need is not required.

AWARD CRITERIA:

- Minimum 2.5 GPA;
- Membership and demonstrated service/involvement at a parish or other faith community; and
- Interest in some aspect of fine or performing arts.

APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

1. **Proof of GPA:** Current high school students must attach their most recent transcript, showing a cumulative grade point average. Incoming freshmen (current 8th grade students) must attach complete 7th grade and first quarter 8th grade report cards.
