

Louise Huennekens Family Scholarship

Louise Huennekens was a widow who sent seven children through St. Catherine's High School. As a single parent, she valued the Catholic education her children received at SCHS and made the sacrifices necessary to achieve that goal. The love and nurturing of family was the driving force in her life. The Louise Huennekens Family Scholarship Fund was established by her family to honor her memory and to assist an eligible single-parent family who values a quality Christian education.

This \$1,500 scholarship, to be used towards tuition, will be awarded initially to an incoming freshman who is the child of a single parent. However, this is a **renewable award for up to four years**, assuming that the winner maintains his or her eligibility.

AWARD CRITERIA:

- 1. GPA of 2.0 or better;
- 2. Demonstrated community service and involvement in school activities or clubs;
- 3. Residence in a single-parent household; and
- 4. Demonstrate financial need by having the parent complete the Siena Catholic Schools financial aid application before the January 17, 2024 application deadline.

The scholarship will be renewable as long as the recipient remains a student in good standing at St. Catherine's High School, maintains an average (2.0) or better GPA, and continues to participate in school activities and community service.

MATERIALS TO BE PROVIDED BY THE STUDENT:

- 1. An unofficial transcript through the most recent semester showing courses attempted and grades earned.
- 2. A list of community service work, school clubs and activities for the past two years.
