

Marsha Ernst Krueger '59 Scholarship

The Marsha Ernst Krueger '59 Scholarship recognizes a continuing female student with strong academic achievement and a desire to continue their studies in college.

This is a one-year scholarship for rising juniors or seniors who qualify for financial aid. Preference is given to applicants who will be a first generation college student on either side of their family.

AWARD CRITERIA:

- Current female sophomore or junior at St. Catherine's who qualifies for financial aid by a
 parent completing the Siena Catholic Schools financial aid application
 (<u>https://studentfinancialaid.blackbaud.school/#!/login</u>) before the January 17, 2024
 deadline;
- carries a 3.5 cumulative GPA or better; and
- has a desire to attend college following high school.

MATERIALS TO BE SUBMITTED:

- 1. A copy of the applicant's most recent unofficial transcript.
- 2. Completion of a one-page, double-spaced essay addressing the following question.

How is St. Catherine's preparing you for success in college?

3. Answer the following question about your family:
