Dr. George & Marie Smullen Memorial Scholarship

The Dr. George and Marie Smullen Memorial Scholarship is an endowed award housed at the St. Catherine's High School Foundation. George and Marie's children – Mary Lee Smullen Croatt '57, Michael Smullen '59 and George Smullen, Jr. '62 – established this scholarship in honor of their parents.

This is a \$2,500 tuition scholarship, with up to three recipients, that is automatically renewable for the student's next school year, if he/she maintains eligibility.

AWARD CRITERIA:

- 2.67 or better cumulative GPA;
- Applicant's family demonstrates moderate to severe financial need, evidenced by the completion of the Siena Catholic Schools financial aid application (<https://studentfinancialaid.blackbaud.school/#!/login>); and
- Proven good citizenship and community involvement.

Priority will be given to an Our Lady of Grace Academy graduate.

MATERIALS TO BE SUBMITTED

1. Grades 9-11: Attach a copy of your 2022-23 report card to show cumulative GPA. For current 8th graders: Attach a copy of your full-year 2022-23 report card as well as a copy of your current report card for 2023-24, to date, showing courses attempted and grades earned.
2. Complete the Siena Catholic Schools financial aid application by a parent, to be submitted separately (see above award criteria for web address); and
3. A **typed, double-spaced essay of no more than one page**, listing any activities that demonstrate community involvement and good citizenship. This could include volunteer work, sports, church-related functions, work experience, clubs, Scouts, etc.
