

The Rosemary Haas Jansen Memorial Scholarship

Rosemary Haas Jansen was a graduate of St. Catherine's Class of 1952. She believed strongly in her Catholic faith and in the power of a Catholic education and the values it instills. This scholarship has been established in her memory to promote Catholic education and to encourage students to use their faith-based academic experiences to better their community and the world around them.

This \$1,000 scholarship will be applied directly to tuition expenses at SCHS for a rising sophomore, junior or senior. Prior recipients may reapply each year that they are eligible.

Award criteria:

- 1. Recipient must demonstrate a commitment to their Catholic faith, community service and a strong work ethic;
- 2. GPA of 2.75 or higher; and
- 3. Membership and demonstrated service/involvement at a Catholic parish.

Materials to be submitted:

- 1. A transcript through the most recent semester showing courses attempted and grades earned.
- 2. Submission of a **typed, double-spaced** document of not more than two pages in length listing your activities. Include parish involvement, community service, extracurricular activities, work experience, etc. Be sure to include leadership positions and any awards or honors received.
- 3. Submission of a **typed, double-spaced** essay of no more than one page in length, explaining: What brought you to St. Catherine's and how do you plan to use this faith-based education to help benefit and change the world around you?
